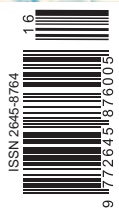

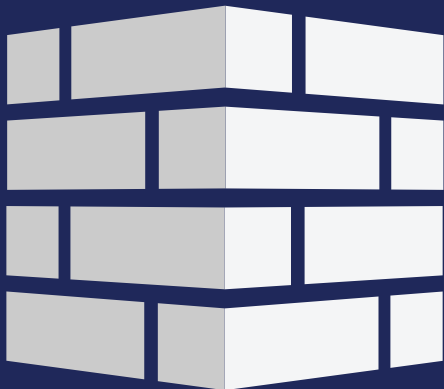
SULAYMANIYE LIBRARY IS

"Of course, I do. Masha Allah, how quickly he grew!"

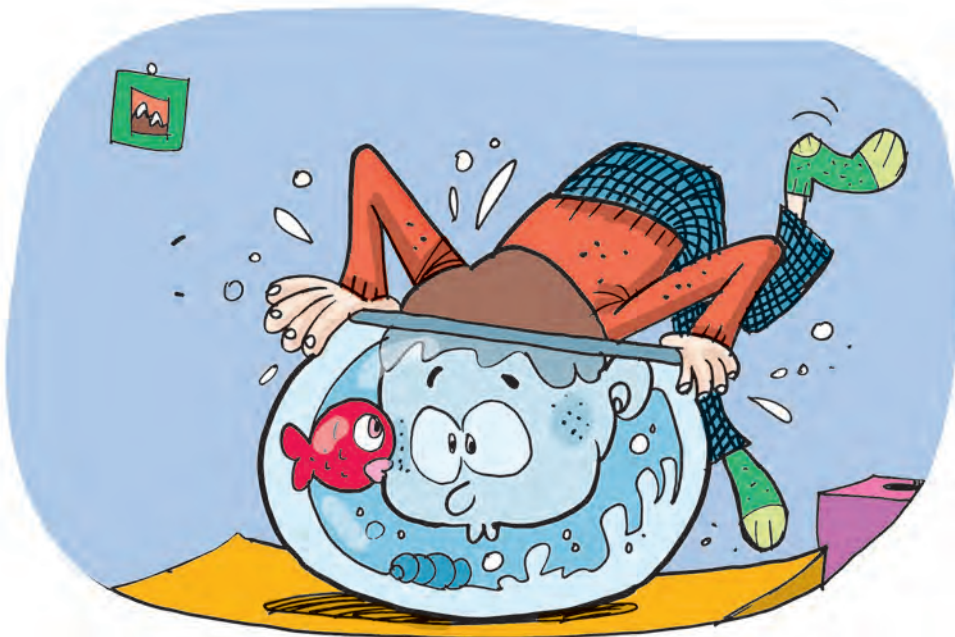
## Why don't fish make a sound

No one volunteered to answer the question. After a while, Ali stood up and answered:

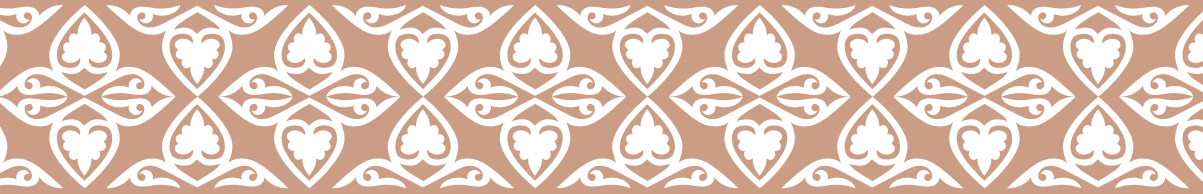
"Sir, even if it were you who lived in the water, we wouldn't hear you talking either."

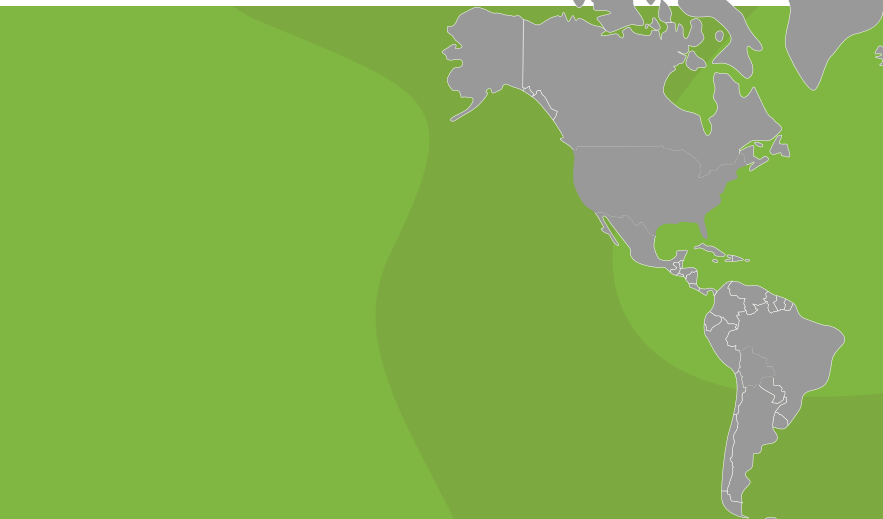
# INDONESIA
