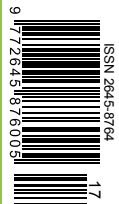

## The Invisible Fish

Scientists have discovered a new species of fish far down in the deepest darkest depths of the ocean. These fish live in complete darkness and are even “invisible” when light is directed at them. It is believed that the fish’s skin has the ability to absorb light, that is why it cannot be seen.

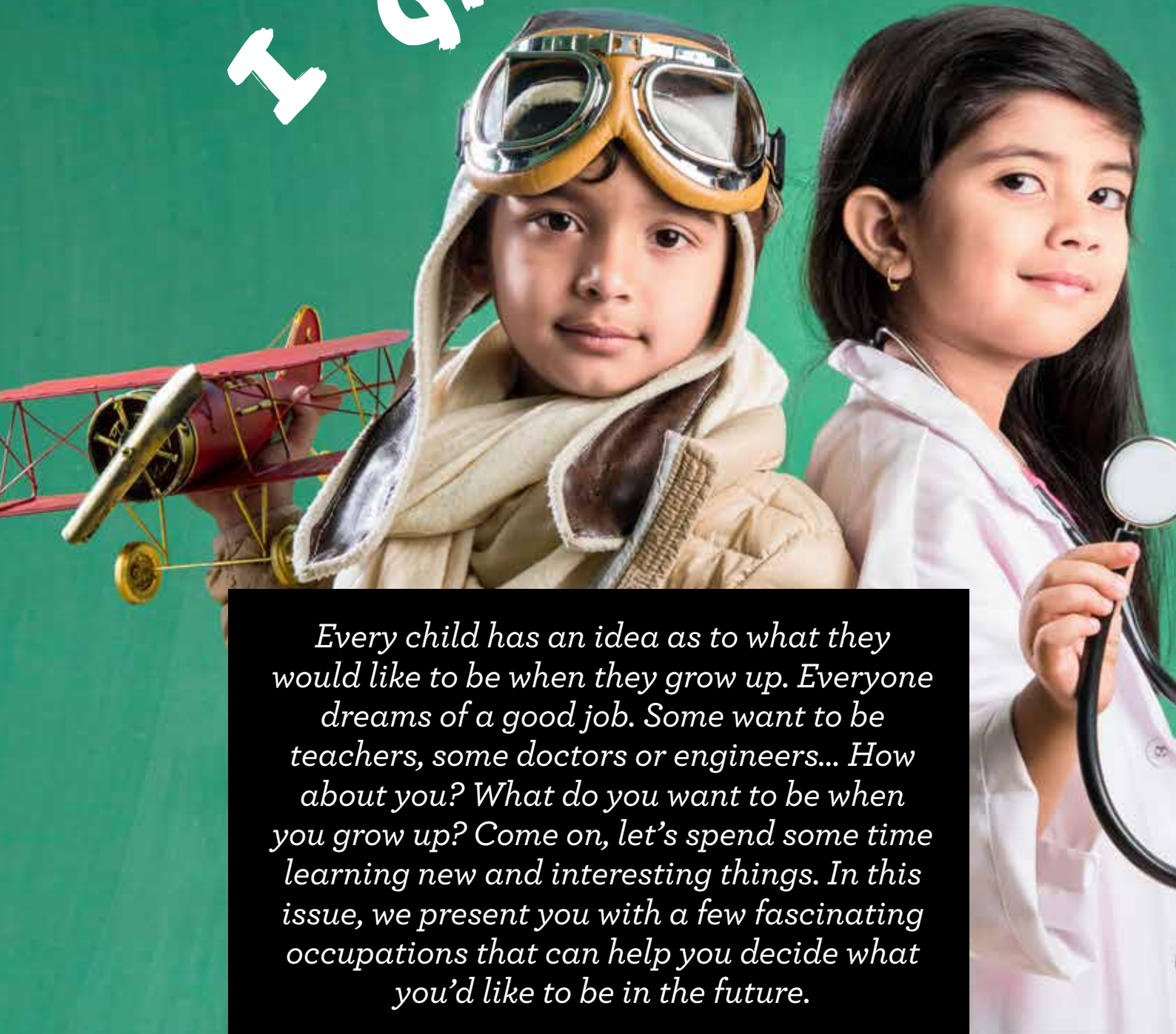


## Hydrogen-powered boat

The world’s first hydrogen-powered boat is now out sailing the seas. The boat has been measured at 100 meters in length. It uses a combination of solar, wind and hydrogen power and is the first of its kind. It is capable of obtaining pure water by electrolyzing seawater. It splits the purified water into its atomic components, stores the hydrogen and uses it as fuel. In addition, thanks to its huge solar batteries, which is 202 square meters, it can produce enough energy to power the boat.

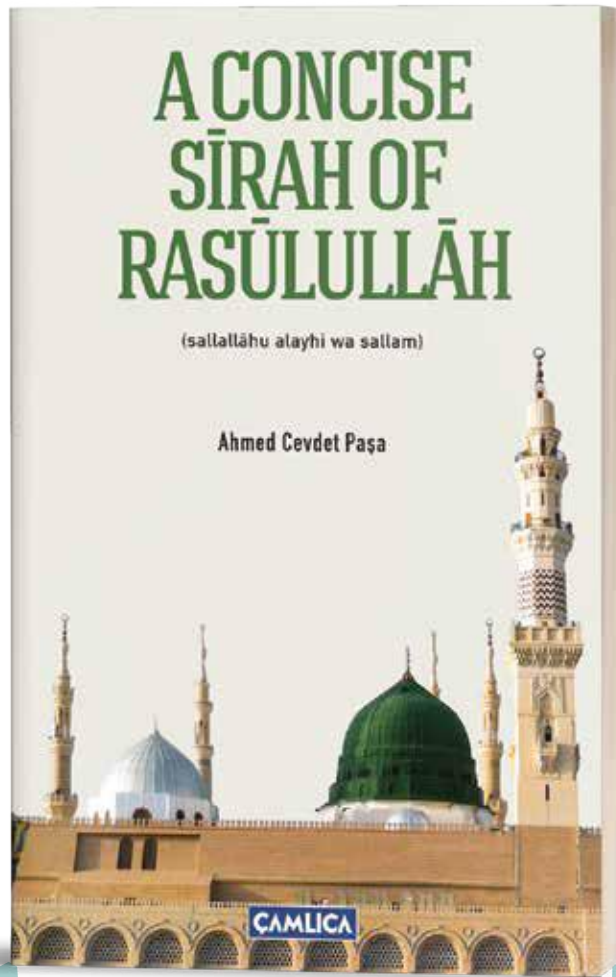
# MADAGASCAR
